


Miyazaki Country Club



Phoenix Country Club



Opened in 1960, this is Miyazaki Prefecture's most historic course - an alluring, seaside onegreen (Korai grass) course packed full of strategic features that skillfully utilize the natural pine groves and undulations of natural beauty. Conveniently located next to Miyazaki Airport and only 20 minutes from downtown Miyazaki, this full-fledged championship course also hosts a women's professional golf tournament every November.

18th Hole Par 4 PICK UP



A dogleg to the left with double-tiered green and height difference in the center. From the second cut, you'll be facing uphill, and you'll find club selection challenging.

PICK UP **Next to airport**



Five minutes by car from Miyazaki Airport. You'll be teeing up within 30 minutes of arrival!

One of Japan's most prestigious courses, and the site of the legendary Dunlop Phoenix Tournament since its beginning, in 1974. Twenty-seven holes are set amid the black pine groves of the Hitotsuba Coast. Exciting as it is beautiful, the course can be played year-round on green, Western-style turf. This enchanting course will inspire the golfer in you to rise to the challenge.

Remote-controlled electromagnetic guided carts are available to get you around. All carts come with navigation systems, allowing non-caddied golfers to play in safety and comfort.

Situated at an elevation of 70 meters, the hilly course has been laid out with a mix of long, short, wide, narrow, uphill, and downhill elements on every hole. The course is maintained to strict tour standards and gets strongly positive word-of-mouth. There are GPS-equipped carts for both caddied and noncaddied players. This is a course that can be enjoyed by beginners and single-digit players alike.



Situated on the banks of the Oyodo River that flows through the heart of Miyazaki City, the flat layout includes both long and short courses. Play two rounds of nine holes on the downstreamside long course for 2,200JPY weekdays, or 3,300JPY weekends and holidays. Or choose the short course on the upstream side for 1,100JPY weekdays, 1,600JPY weekends and holidays. With the lowest rates in the region, even beginners can afford to play anytime.

1st Hole Par 5 PICK UP

The menu features a wide range of dishes from set meals to noodles. The most popular item is the generous deep-fried chicken set meal.

The course extends across hilly terrain in Kunitomi-cho, adjacent to Miyazaki City. Moderate elevation differences impart a strategic feel to this flat course, making it fun to attack. The front nine has wide fairways that allow for bold play, but the lies can be difficult. Beginners will enjoy this course, yet it offers depth for experts too. The back nine puts accuracy above distance, and there's an allure to the final hole that makes you want to tackle it again and again.

This public course stretches along the banks of the Hitotsuse River. The flat course is easy to play even for beginners. The fairways are gentle and spacious, but even advanced players cannot be caught off guard as the flat course, which requires directionality rather than distance, has exquisite undulations, bunkers, ponds, and other hazards.

This is the toughest hole at over 560 yards, with out-of-bounds on the left and a one-shot penalty on the right. Your tee shot will be the key.

The second-oldest and most prestigious course in the prefecture, opened in 1967. Situated on a 200-meter elevation south of Mimitsu, Hyuga City, which is famous for its association with the legendary first emperor of Japan, this long-hole, strategic hilly course is separated by 1,200 bayberry trees, and attracts golfers from all over Japan. You'll see the beautiful Pacific Ocean from the clubhouse and some points on the course. An exhilarating golfing experience.
