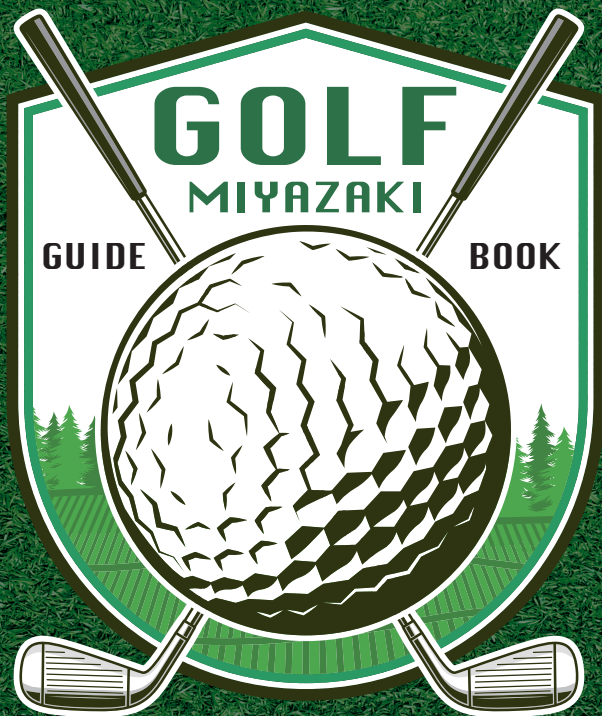


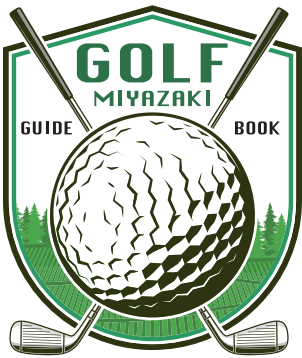

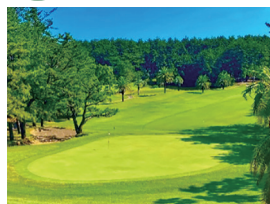




A championship course that tests your strategic skills

Opened in 1960, this is Miyazaki Prefecture's most historic course — an alluring, seaside one-green (Korai grass) course packed full of strategic features that skillfully utilize the natural pine groves and undulations of natural beauty. Conveniently located next to Miyazaki Airport and only 20 minutes from downtown Miyazaki, this full-fledged championship course also hosts a women's professional golf tournament every November.

PICK UP 18th Hole Par 4



A dogleg to the left with double-tiered green and height difference in the center. From the second cut, you'll be facing uphill, and you'll find club selection challenging.

Five minutes by car from Miyazaki Airport. You'll be teeing up within 30 minutes of arrival!

One of Japan's premier courses, meeting top players from around the world

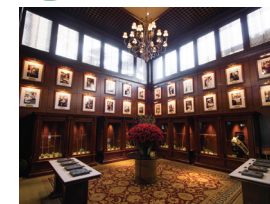

A hillside course bathed in tropical sunshine. The 27 holes of the Tachibana, Kirishima, and Osuzu courses feature broad fairways and gentle undulations combined with tricky undulations large and small. Varied play amid tropical breezes makes for a thoroughly enjoyable golf experience.

The out-of-bounds line continues on the right side. The distance is relatively short, giving you a chance to birdie even with normal shots.

A balmy course offering year-round play



Situated close to the geographic center of the prefecture, this gently hilly course makes the most of the natural terrain. The front nine is flat and well-separated, while the back nine is marked by gently sloping fairways with moderate undulations. The two-green system ensures excellent year-round playing conditions, and the many guard bunkers surrounding the greens will put your strategy and technique to the test. Electromagnetic guided carts available for a relaxing experience.

A long hole with a dogleg left. The depression in front of the green means your second shot must be placed accurately.

A symphony in time and space, this course with its lovely setting is also an exercise in strategy. The front nine, with majestic fairways and exquisite undulations and hazards, requires an advanced ensemble of power and technique. The back nine, with magnificent views of the Hyuga Sea, the peaks of Kirishima, and sparkling water hazards, will touch the spirit of the golfer in you. And the scenery, a complex balance of tension and ease, will deliver the best in golfing enjoyment.

A long middle hole. Your second shot will be over a large pond in front of the green.

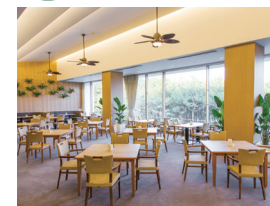

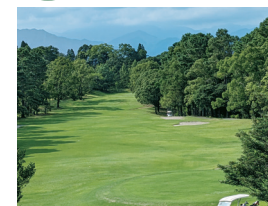

This public course stretches along the banks of the Hitotsuse River. The flat course is easy to play even for beginners. The fairways are gentle and spacious, but even advanced players cannot be caught off guard as the flat course, which requires directionality rather than distance, has exquisite undulations, bunkers, ponds, and other hazards.

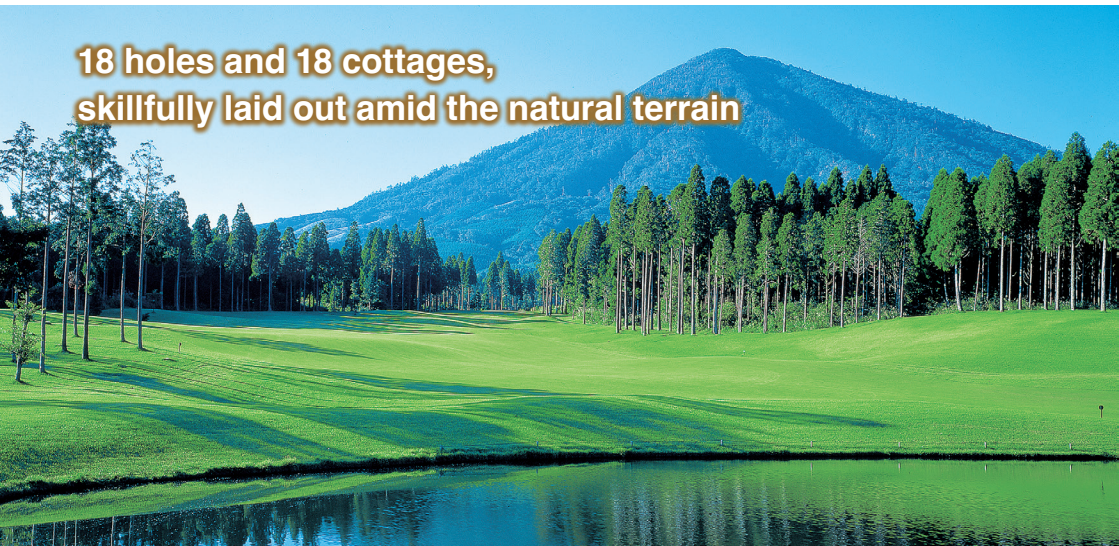

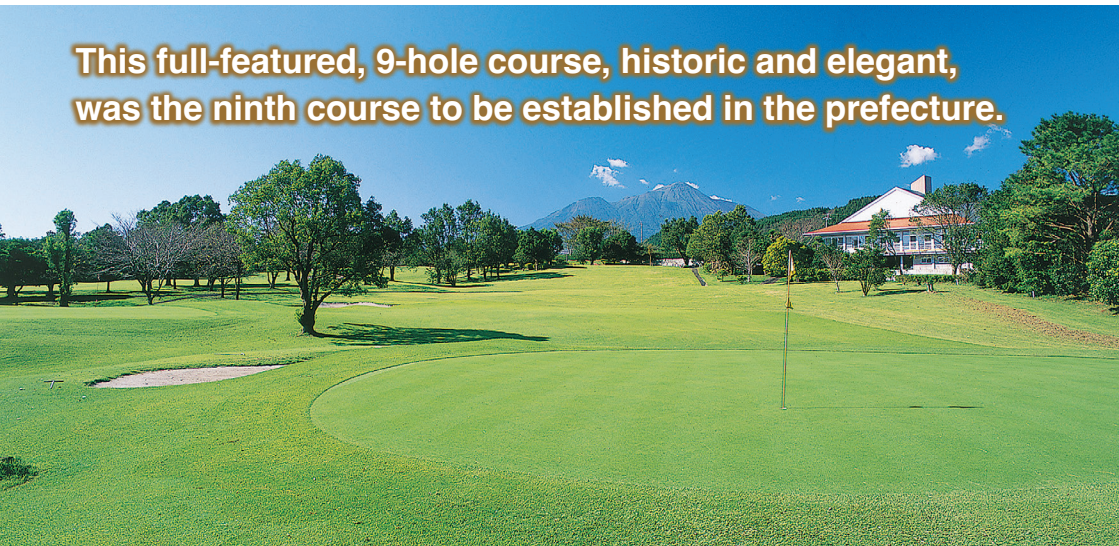

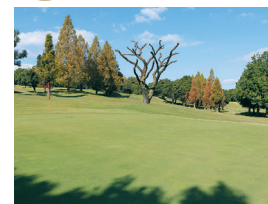
Takaharu Golf Club
